FY 2019 CDBG – Glenolden Park Walking Path – Phase 2

OHCD authorized award to A to U and we have forwarded contracts for their execution. Once fully executed we will schedule the required Pre-Construction meeting with the County.

Academy Ave. Repaving

Ridley Township is proposing to resurface Academy Avenue and they have asked if the Borough would like to participate with their half from the border with the Township to South Avenue. The estimated cost is \$20,000 and the 2020/2021 County Aid amounts to \$17,416 with the balance being able to be paid from Liquid Fuels Funds. If Council is in agreement, we will coordinate the necessary paperwork through PennDOT Municipal Services.

Academy and Hibbs Avenue Bridges

PennDOT representative Meg Sherman sent another email to Ridley Township and Darby Township requesting acknowledgement of ownership and responsibility for their proportionate share of costs associated with the inspection and maintenance of the Academy Ave. bridge. Upon their acknowledgement, Ms. Sherman suggested that the Borough acknowledge the change in ownership and it may prompt the others to do so for the cost sharing arrangement previously reported. **NO CHANGE**

Former Glenolden Swim Club

We are awaiting the re-submission of plans to determine if all conditions of approval have been met for recording purposes. Once reviewed we will have signed and sealed copies for the Borough's signature. The applicant is working through issues with PennDOT and PADEP for permits required. **NO CHANGE**

MacDade Signal Project

Construction is progressing.

Glenolden Community Park GSI and Walking Trail

DCNR has requested additional information be provided for the plan accompanying the Grant application. Per discussion with the Borough Manager today, those changes are being completed.

Glenolden Ave. Parking Concerns

Per the request of the Borough Manager, we are reviewing.

South Ave. Bridge

The County has requested survey information on the existing sanitary sewer that currently runs under the bridge. Their re-design requires the sewer to be relocated.

112 S. Glen Ave. and 47 E. Knowles Ave. drainage complaints

Per the request of the Borough Manager, we met with the homeowners and reviewed their concerns with the construction of a new shed at the neighboring property at 43 E. Knowles Ave. which they mentioned has caused stormwater run-off issues on their properties. We are still working on the report for the Borough.

Review Right to Know Request

A Right to Know request was submitted for documentation of any pedestrian signage installed by the Borough back in 2009-2010 era at the intersection of Oak Ave and Chester Pike. The address in question is in Folcroft Borough and it is our understanding all signage associated with the traffic signal would have been installed by PennDOT during their signal upgrade project.
